DAILY MAINTENANCE

		
<p>Clean the dirty water tank.</p>	<p>Check the suction filter is undamaged and clean.</p>	<p>Check that the detergent outlet filter is clean.</p>

		 <p>BATTERY CHARGER STAND ALONE</p>
<p>Check that the brushes are clean.</p>	<p>Check that the squeegee is clean and the blades are not worn.</p>	

REPLACING THE SQUEEGEE BLADES

unscrew the wing nuts fixing the blade retainer;
 remove the blade retainer;
 remove the blade;
 put the same blade back, reversing the edge in contact with the floor, or replace with a new one;
 reposition the blade retainer and fix the wing nuts back;

ATTACHING/REMOVING THE BRUSHES

Attaching:
 Press the "Click-Off-On" button. The machine first performs a release operation, then immediately afterwards enables the attachment operation. Press the "Click-Off-On" button again to automatically attach the brushes.

Releasing:
 Press the "Click-Off-On" button, the machine releases the brushes.
